Thanks to our donors, who were encouraged by God to participate in the Project of donation of packages of school supplies, in the months of January-February 2017 we were able to benefit almost 300 children and adolescents with a complete package of school supplies according to the level of study in which they are.

We toured several remote areas of the country to reach many of the most needy children: Cubujuquí de Sarapiquí, Guápiles, Tres Ríos, Barranca de Puntarenas, Los Guido de Desamparados, La Aurora de Heredia, Aserrí, Guácimo, Barrio México, La Guácima de Alajuela , Etc.

Two camps, one for children from 7 to 12 years; and another for teens, in July 2017, have greatly edified us.

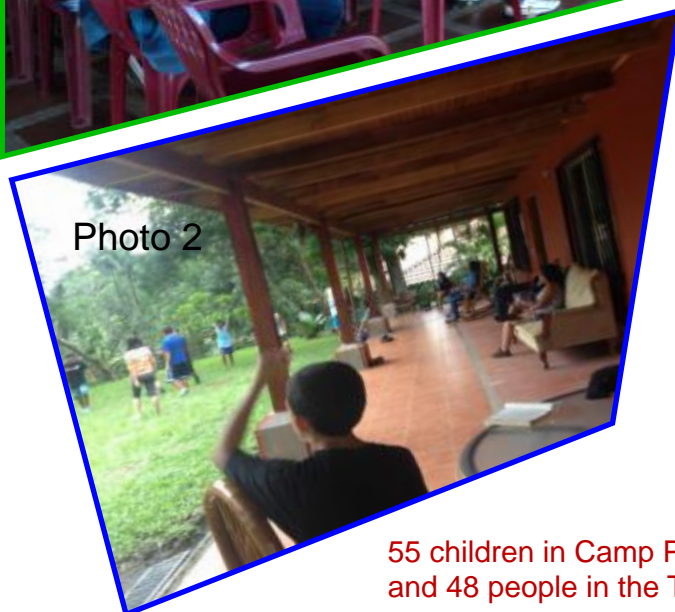

Face painting course

Thanks to the collaboration of Lic. Ana María Granados, the face painting course was held with teenagers from one of our programs located in Pococí, Limón. The mastery of this technique today, has a very important demand, mainly if they develop themes allusive to nature.

Tubers' flour is a reality

For more than 20 years, we have been observing a decrease in the planting of tubers in the Atlantic Zone. This is due in large part to the cultural change that our kitchen suffers.

As vegetables, the tubers are very delicious and highly nutritious and have always been part of the culinary taste of Costa Ricans (tiquisque, ñampí, malanga, sweet potato, cassava, among others). To promote their use in Bakery and Confectionery we are inclined to produce the flours of these tubers under the dehydration process, obtaining a high-quality product.

This initiative was developed primarily as an approach to this type of process, but the initiative was overcome and we see a good teaching possibility for the population served. This is a productive project of sociocultural type.
